PROCLAMATION

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives, with the full approval of the Senate, passed Resolution #226 naming August 14, 2010, as Spirit of '45 Day; and

WHEREAS, on August 14, 1945, the people of the United States received word that World War II had ended; and

WHEREAS, August 14, 1945, marked not only the end of the war, but also the beginning of an unprecedented era of rebuilding in which the United States led an effort to restore shattered nations and to create institutions to work towards a more peaceful global community; and

WHEREAS, the entire World War II generation, both military and civilian, has provided a model of unity and community that serves as a source of inspiration for current and future generations of Americans to come together to work for the continued betterment of the United States and the world; and

WHEREAS, August 14, 2010, marks the 65th anniversary of the end of World War II;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GREGORY A. BALLARD, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AUGUST 14, 2010 AS:

SPIRIT OF '45 DAY
